



Ada Community Library - Library Card Design Contest

Rules:

- ♦ This contest is open to residents of all ages within Ada County, with the exception of Ada Community Library staff or employees
- ♦ Entries are limited to two per person
- ♦ Entries may be submitted into one of two design categories: digital photo or hand-drawn
- ♦ All submitted images/image components must be original and address the theme
- ♦ All entries must be accompanied by a completed Entry and Photo/Drawing Release Agreement

Theme: "Dreams, Ideas and Information"

Ada Community Library is seeking photos and drawings that symbolize Ada Community Library's mission for library service: "The Ada Community Library is committed to providing a broad range of library materials and services; offering personalized assistance for all community residents; encouraging early literacy and life-long learning; and increasing cooperation and resource sharing among area libraries." The winning photo and drawing will be incorporated into the design of future official Ada Community Library cards.

Deadline for submissions:

January 26, 2008

Submission (Entry and Photo/Drawing Release Agreement):

All submissions must be accompanied by a completed Entry and Photo/Drawing Release Agreement. Participation in the contest constitutes the participant's express consent to the use of the participant's submitted artwork and/or photos by the Ada Community Library without compensation or limitation or other reservation of rights by the participant. Please read the complete contest rules on the Entry and Photo/ Drawing Release Agreement before signing and submitting your entry.

Judging:

Submissions will be judged for quality and effective representation of the theme. The winner will be determined by a judging panel and through a community vote. The judging panel will consist of library staff and community members with expertise in photography or art. All submitted photos and drawings will be displayed on the library's webpage and in the three Ada Community Library locations for community vote, with voting to take place in person or on-line. Judging and voting will take place between January 28 and Feb 2, 2008. Winners will be personally notified; a subsequent announcement of the winner will be found on the library's website and in all Ada Community Library locations.

Prize:

The winning photo and drawing will be featured on an official library card of the Ada Community Library. Winners will also receive a gift certificate and library reference book.

Rules

1. Contest open to Ada County residents of all ages (Ada Community Library staff or employees are ineligible).
2. Only submissions including original (taken, generated, or otherwise produced by the participant) photos or drawings addressing the theme will be accepted. Submissions containing images of copyrighted material will not be accepted.
3. Submission of photos or drawings by an entrant constitutes a representation and warranty that such photos or drawings are original to or were created by the entrant and are not otherwise the intellectual property of any other individual or entity.
4. Submissions must be in color.
5. Submissions must be accompanied by this Entry and Photo/Drawing Release Agreement.

7. Only two submissions per entrant will be accepted. Each entry must be submitted separately.

Full contact information for each entrant must be provided on this Entry and Photo/Drawing Release Agreement and will be used for confirmation of receipt of each submission and, if applicable, congratulatory contact. Any personal information submitted in connection with this Library Card Design Contest will NOT be sold, distributed, or otherwise used for marketing purposes.

Upon submission of an entry, each entrant grants Ada Community Library all rights to the photo(s)/drawing(s) contained in such submission and consents that such photo(s)/drawing(s) may be displayed and/or reproduced without limitation and without compensation to the individual submitting such photo(s)/drawing(s).
10. Submission of any entries including photographs of person or persons constitute consent by the entrant that such photos regardless of the identity of the individuals depicted in such photographs, may be displayed, published, or printed in venues deemed appropriate by Ada Community Library staff.

Any submission that does not meet the above criteria will not be considered.
