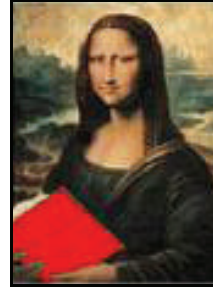

Ages 0 - 24 months

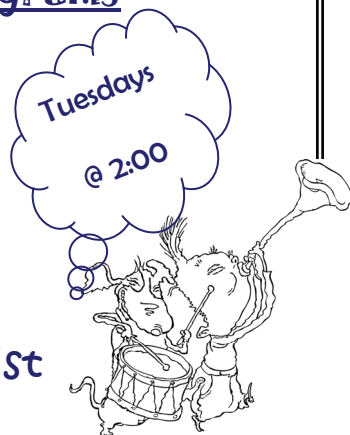
